No experience is necessary for this fun introductory class. It has been specially designed for young athletes to learning all the fundamentals. Our recreational program focuses on developing the foundation for a future in the sport of cheerleading. Our curriculum includes stunting, tumbling, jumps, dance, learning choreography, cheer vocabulary as well as development of coordination, flexibility, strength, teamwork, and confidence.

#### RECREATIONAL PLUS

We are excited to announce this division of our recreational program. Want to return to cheer? Want to maintain your skills but can't commit to a full competitive season? Do you have experience in other sports and you are looking for something new? This team is built for you! This program is for athletes who want to train at a higher level without the pressure of competition. Athletes that are part of masters will have practices once per week for the season.. Curriculum includes stunting, tumbling, jumps, dance, learning choreography for a routine to perform at the showcases.

### NOVICE

Our Novice program is the start of our competitive track. Novice is the perfect step between recreational and allstar. Athletes get the experience of learning a choreographed routine where they are taught the fundamentals of a competitive routine without the expense and travel commitment. Athletes will practice twice per week for two hours, and participate in our showcase and local competitions to show off their amazing talents to family and friends. Athletes skill assessments may be required for placement.

### ALL-STAR CHEER

All-star is a major component of competitive cheer. With more than 40 different divisions and levels available, Renegade Cheer teams for this coming season will be determine after try outs, but can change to "level up" and optimize the success of our athletes. Our competitive teams require a high level of commitment and will receive advanced training, personalized coaching, and opportunities to showcase their skills at various competitions.

#### COMPETITIVE

For athletes of all ages aspiring to compete at the regional and national level. Our All-star teams are for athletes ranging in skill levels 1-4. Our teams have varied age groups and are created based on our programs needs after level training. With the experience and track record of our coaching staff we will help our athletes understand technique, and fine-tune their skill set.

#### WORLDS

Our worlds program is for level 5-7 athletes and is our most competitive program. These teams require a high level of dedication and discipline. Our worlds teams will be required to attend an event(s) that offer bids to the IASF Cheerleading Worlds to earn a "at large" or "partial paid bid to compete at the Cheerleading World Championships held in Orlando, Florida in late April. # LEVEL TRAINING

Level training will allow coaches to further assess an athlete's skill level and provide time to discuss developmental goals with athletes and parents.

Athletes's tumbling and stunting abilities, as well as team needs are taken into account as the form It is crucial that we take the time to do this as we want to form competitive teams and are committed to setting athletes up for success in training and in competition.

Following try outs athletes will be placed for at level training, announcement will be released via email no later than May 31st. Registration and payment for their level training is required prior to the first training session. Level training is set to take place from June 1st - June 14th.

Level training fee of \$295 + GST includes training time of four 1.5 hour sessions in June, Renegade Reveal and administrative fees.

\*This is a non-refundable fee that must be paid prior to the first at-level training session.

### INCLUDED IN FEES:

**Recreational / Recreational Plus**: Monthly tuition, practice t-shirt, open gym, professional choreography, professional music, professional team photo(digital), insurance, and admin fee.

**Novice, All-Star Competitive, and Worlds**: Monthly tuition, monthly training classes, practice t-shirt, open gym, professional choreography, professional music, professional team photo, guest coaches, insurance, admin fee, competition fees (excluded: NCA, Summit, Worlds, ICU fees).

### NOT INCLUDED IN FEES:

Uniforms, hair, accessory, shoes, travel competition fees (NCA, Summit, Worlds, ICU), travel and accommodations.



### INSTALLMENT INFORMATION:

NOVICE: 8 equal installments, first payment will be at the time of registration. Then the remaining payments on the installment plans, regardless of registration date, will be withdrawn on the first of the month, starting October 2024, ending April 2025.

ALL-STAR: 11 equal installments, first payment will be at the time of registration. Then the remaining payments on the installment plans, regardless of registration date, will be withdrawn on the first of the month, starting July 2024, ending April 2025.

### ALTERNATIVE PAYMENT OPTIONS:

To ensure that cheerleading is accessible to everyone, we're happy to accommodate families that need alternative payment arrangements. Please email us to request and discuss alternation payment options.

### LATE REGISTRATION:

Late registrants are required to pay the non-refundable registration fee for the 2024-2025 season in addition to the All-inclusive team investment. Registration is pending team availability. It is deemed late registration if an athlete did not attend the level-training hosted in June 2024.

#### UNIFORMS

We are starting Year 1 of a 3 year uniform cycle. Unifrom is mandatory for the following teams.

- Novice \$200+GST
- All-Star Competitive \$450 \$550 +GST

\*Costs for uniforms are approximate and will be confirmed closer to Renegade Reveal.

Uniform Sizing to start night of Renegade Reveal. Order deadline to be announced. 50% deposit required at time of order.

### SHOES

Recreational - Indoor running shoes are required. Novice, All-Star - Cheerleading shoes are required.

Cheerleading shoes will be available for purchase or order. \*Specific colour will be determined and announced closer to the competition season.



### **COMPETITION SCHEDULE**

We are working on putting together a top notch competition schedule for the upcoming season, we'll establish and solidify our event list in partnership with our Renegade family of new team athletes/parents.

We are currently exploring options for our upcoming season aim to build a competition schedule that best reflects the team, schedule and our families. Provided are a sample of events that we are considering attending.

While we would like the majority of our teams to attend the same competitions and travel as a collective, listed competitions are tentative and not all teams will attend all competitions. Travelling as a group benefits our teams and helps to build relationships within our program. Athletes will have the opportunity to bond and go through these experiences together, motivating athletes to work as a collective and help each other achieve greatness. This also benefits families with multiple athletes on varying teams to attend and support each other.

Competition fees are included in the allinclusive pricing with the exception of out of province events/competitions.

# BOLICIES E CREDITS

We plan to offer fee discounts and credits for athletes who are out of high school, travel from outside Calgary city limits, cross over to other teams, and families that have siblings in the program. We will provide more information on discounts and credits before the beginning of the season. Fees will be finalized before tryouts.

Additional payment information, refund policies, and waivers will also be published before tryouts.

#### SIBLING RATE:

Families with multiple athletes registered in the Novice or All-Star program are eligible to request a sibling credit starting June 10th, 2025. Credit will be applied when registering for a team and must be used within the 2024 - 2025 season.

#### **REFUND POLICY:**

Withdrawal from a team must be done by the 20th of the month through email to info@renegadecheer.com to allow for payment adjustments. Cancellation outside of that timeframe is not subject to refund.

- Within 1 month of registration Full refund of All-inclusive fees.
- Prior to October 1st 40% of the applicable tuition is retained by Renegade Cheer
- Prior to November 1st 55% of applicable tuition is retained by Renegade Cheer
- Prior to December 1st 65% of the applicable tuition is retained by Renegade Cheer
- On or after December 1st No refund will be issued.
